Applies to non-alcohol retail establishments, as defined and categorized pursuant to 3-1(gg) of the Columbus Code, which will permit customers to bring their own malt beverages and wine onto the business premises during hours when alcoholic beverages could otherwise be sold pursuant to referenced subsection.
