



The Air Quality Alliance of the Chattahoochee Valley is excited to announce a new Commuter Rewards program made available to our area by the Georgia Clean Air Campaign. Commuter Rewards is an incentive program open to commuters who live and work in Georgia. Now you can take control of your commute and save time and money – even better, you can earn cash and win prizes by participating! There are a variety of options available, and plenty of people to help you figure out how to get started.

Cash for Commuters rewards commuters who currently drive alone to work when they agree to start using a clean commute alternative. Start carpooling, teleworking, using transit, walking or bicycling to work and earn \$3 per day, up to \$180 over an assigned 90-day period.

If you are already carpooling or using another clean commute alternative, you may be eligible to participate in other Commuter Rewards programs. By logging your commute on the Daily Commute Log, you can be eligible for **Commuter Prizes**. Each month, participants are entered into a random drawing for \$25 gift cards. Some commuters may even win Spotlight Awards of \$100! Through **Carpool Rewards**, carpools of three or more people who log enough trips each month can earn gas cards of \$40 or \$60.

Want to participate, but can't find a carpool partner? Try RideSmart. When you register, simply indicate that you would like to receive a list of potential carpool or vanpool partners, and a list will be sent to you, courtesy of RideSmart. Or you can visit www.MyRideSmart.com.
