II. QUESTION(S)/RESPONSE(S)

Question 1: On page 17, item. E. Past Performance indicates that we need to include references from past GDOT projects and that this section accounts for 10% of the overall score. However, on pages 18-24, Section V. Instructions for Content and Preparation of the RFP Response, does not request these references. Please clarify if we need to include client references within our response and whether preference will be given to GDOT projects over the other agencies.

Response: Yes, please complete the attached Exhibit XII – Client Work History.

This project is GDOT funded. Therefore, experience with GDOT projects is preferred.

Question 2: (a) Can the City confirm whether ADA compliance and facility condition are to be evaluated for all existing pedestrian, sidewalk, and trail facilities Citywide?

(b) What level of condition data is the City looking for?

(c) Does the City have any data regarding present condition and ADA facilities, and if so, what format is it in?

Response: (a) Yes. (b) We would like to know what needs to be done to correct a problem. (c) No. Dragonfly and 311 currently keep us apprised of issues with trails and sidewalks.

Question 3: Please clarify the required format and level of detail for the Cost Proposal, as the RFP specifies that it must be submitted separately but does not provide guidance on layout, required cost breakdown, or specific components to include.

Response: The level of detail and layout are at the discretion of the submitting firm. However, there should be a breakout of what each type of work will cost.

Question 4: Several evaluation criteria refer to “experience in utilizing GDOT specific processes, manuals, or guidance” for the project manager, key team leaders, and key team members, as well as performance on previous GDOT projects. Will the entire team’s qualifications regarding GDOT experience be considered for evaluation, or will only the Prime firm’s experience with GDOT be counted toward these evaluations?

Response: Only the Prime firm’s experience with GDOT will be considered.

Question 5: Can the City share what ArcGIS base layers related to sidewalks and trails they have and what specific datasets are included?

Response: In addition to our Sidewalks layer, the GIS Division has the following transportation-related layers:

- ADA Curb Ramps
- Crosswalks
- Pedestrian Signals
- Streets City
- Streets Unamed
- Roundabouts
- Trails (both Local and Regional Trails)
- Trail signage
- Trail Mile Markers
- Trails Parking
- Trail
- Bicycle Boxes
- Bicycle lane Crossing
- Bicycle Lanes
- Bicycle Sharrows
- Bicycle Racks

Question 6: Per Addendum #4, “*Exceptions May be submitted up to five (5) days prior to the RPF close date*”, we’d like to submit our exceptions below:

Exception 1: Indemnity (pages 10 and 15 of 52): the indemnity is broad and not designed to maintain professional liability insurance for any project performed thereunder – it should be limited to “the extent that it was caused by negligent acts, errors, or omissions”

Response: Specification Change. Page 10, I. Indemnity and pages 14 – 15, F. Indemnity Clause, are revised as follows:

The Contractor covenants to save, defend, hold harmless, and indemnify the City, and all of its officers, departments, agencies, agents, and employees (collectively the "City") from and against any and all claims, losses, damages, injuries, fines, penalties, costs (including court costs and attorney's fees), charges, liability, or exposure, however caused, resulting from, arising out of, or in any way connected with the Contractor's intentional, negligent, or grossly negligent acts or omissions in performance or nonperformance of its work called for by the Contract Documents.

Exception 2: Insurance Checklist (pages 38-39 of 52): Item 24 – 1) the City cannot be an Additional Insured on ALL policies (only on CGL, Auto, Umbrella); 2) we do not “name” others as Additional Insureds but will provide proof of coverage under a blanket endorsement for the City.

Response: At a minimum, the City shall be named as additional insured on General Liability Premises/Operations.
